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Amano Receives VISA Cardholder Information Security Certification (CISP) on Parking Products

Allows Secure Information for Credit Card Transactions in Pay Stations

October 25, 2006, Roseland, NJ – Amano Cincinnati, Inc., a market leader in parking, time & attendance and security solutions, is excited to announce certification of compliancy with Visa's Cardholder Information Security Program (CISP). The program establishes a set of 12 requirements for safeguarding sensitive information and controlling data access.

To become certified, organizations must submit to an independent security audit to verify compliance on key information-safeguarding requirements. The following Amano parking hardware systems products have met Visa requirements:

- Amano AGP 5200 Fee Computer
- Amano AGP 7800 Pay-on-Foot Pay Station
- Amano AGP 6800 Pay-In-Lane Exit Pay Station
- Amano AGP 9400 AmanoCharge Centralized Credit Card System

The AGP 2050, AGP 6050 and AGP 4300 Expressparc exit pay – since they are not covered in certification because they do not store data.

The recognition by Visa underscores Amano's commitment to provide the highest level of security to our merchants and their customers for their card processing needs. CISP defines a standard of due care for securing Visa cardholder data, wherever it is located. Amano has met all 12 key requirements in the Visa program as follows:

- Install and maintain a working firewall to protect data

- Keep security patches up-to-date
- Protect stored data
- Encrypt data sent across public networks
- Use and regularly update anti-virus software
- Restrict access by "need to know"
- Assign unique ID to each person with computer access
- Don't use vendor-supplied defaults for passwords and security parameters
- Track all access to data by unique ID
- Regularly test security systems and processes
- Implement and maintain an information security policy
- Restrict physical access to data

According to compliancy rules set forth by Visa, compliance must be validated on an annual basis.
